

Embedding your myartspace videos in other websites

myartspace galleries are designed as “objects” that can be inserted into other HTML code on your personal website or myspace page easily and quickly.

Steps involved:

1. Retrieve your gallery that you want to embed in the gallery viewer.
2. Run your mouse over the two clipboards in the lower-right corner of the gallery viewer as per the illustration below. You will see the words “copy URL or embed Code”. Click on that.

3. By clicking on the two clipboards, a dialog box will come up. It gives you the choice of getting the URL link to the gallery or getting the embedded code that you can put inside your personal web page. 4. Insert your embed code from your clipboard using Edit/Paste or Control-V keyboard command (Windows) into your HTML code. Below is a simple example of some HTML code that has an embedded object in it.
